EXAMINATION SCHEME

- There shall be a Five-Year Programme (Semester Scheme) for the degree of B.A. LL.B. for which the teaching shall be conducted through the lecture method, practical learning and class performance during the session and examination shall be conducted through written papers, practical and viva-voce at the end of each semester.
- There shall be 05 papers in each semester i.e. total 50 papers during the course (16 arts papers and 34 law papers including 04 clinical/practical paper of law).
- Each paper shall be of 100 marks & consist of following two parts
 - Written paper 70 marks**

Theory question paper shall be divided into 02 parts viz part - A and part - B.

 - Section A shall consist of 05 compulsory question of 02 marks each.
 - Section B shall consist of 07 long question (15 marks) out of which any 04 question are to be attempted.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1



A candidate who is eligible for the promotion to the next semester shall take re-admission by submitting his/her application form along with the prescribed fee within the prescribed time as decided by university. However, in case of late admitted candidate the attendance will be reckoned from the date of admission of the candidate.

A candidate is require to pass shall obtain at least 36% in each individual paper in each semester and 50% marks in aggregate of all papers of each semester separately during the completion of his/her B.A.LL.B 5 year course.

3



A candidate shall be eligible for promotion to next semester subject to that he/she has secured 36% marks in each paper and 50% in aggregate in at least 3 papers out of 5 papers. Such candidate shall be eligible to re-appear only two consecutive semester examination to pass remaining papers and to secure 50% marks in aggregate of all papers of that semester.

A candidate who has obtained minimum 36% marks in each individual paper and 50% in aggregate at least in 03 paper of semester (I/III/V/VII) shall be eligible to appear at the B.A.LL.B. (III/V/VII/IX) semester examination respectively otherwise he/she shall appear examination of semester (I/III/V/VII) as an ex-student.

A candidate who has obtained minimum 36% marks individual paper and 50% in aggregate at least in 03 paper of semester (II/IV/VI/VIII) shall be eligible to appear at the B.A.LL.B. (IV/VI/VIII/X) semester examination respectively otherwise he/she shall appear examination of semester (II/IV/VI/VIII) as an ex-student.

A candidate admitted for the degree of B.A.LL.B. (5 year course) has to complete his/her degree within seven academic years.

A student can apply for revaluation only in maximum (03) papers if he/she is not satisfied with marks awarded to him/her within 15 days form the date of result declaration. There shall be revaluation fee for each paper as prescribed by the university.

- There shall be a Three-Year Programme (Semester Scheme) for the degree of LL.B. for which the teaching shall be conducted through the lecture method, practical learning and class performance during the session and examination shall be conducted through written papers, practical and viva-voce at the end of each semester.
- There shall be total 36 papers (6 papers each semester) including 04 clinical/practical paper of law.
- Each paper shall consist of following two parts
 - (a) Written paper 80 marks
 - (b) Internal Assessment 20 marks





(a) WRITTEN PAPER (80 MARKS)

Theory question paper shall be divided into 02 parts viz part - A and part B.

Part A shall consist of **07** short question (04 marks) out of which any **05** question are to be attempted.

Part B shall consist of **06** long question (15 marks) out of which any **04** question are to be attempted.

A candidate who has obtained minimum **36%** marks individual paper and **48%** in aggregate at least. in **04** paper of semester (II/IV) shall be eligible to appear at the LL.B. (IV/VI) semester examination respectively otherwise he/she shall appear examination of semester (II/IV) as an ex-student.

06



A candidate admitted for the degree of LL.B. (3 year course) has to complete his/her degree within **six academic year**.

A student can apply for revaluation in maximum (**03**) papers if he/she is not satisfied with marks awarded to him/her within **15 days** of date of result declaration. There shall be revaluation fee for each paper as prescribed by the university.

The Master of Laws (LL.M.) is a two-year postgraduate programme designed to provide advanced knowledge and specialization in various areas of law. The course enhances students' understanding of legal principles and prepares them for research, academics, and professional excellence.

In the first year, students study core subjects such as Law and Social Transformation, Legal Education and Research Methodology, and Constitutional Law of India. In the final year, students choose their area of specialization to develop expertise in a specific legal field.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

01



A candidate required to pass, shall obtain at least **40%** in each year in each individual paper and **50%** marks in the aggregate of all law papers of each year separately during the completion of his/her two years course may be awarded the degree of Master of Law.

02



A candidate shall be eligible for promotion to LL.M. II YEAR subject to that he/she has secured **40%** marks in individual paper & **50%** in aggregate at least in **3** papers out of **5** papers. Such candidate shall be eligible to reappear only in two consecutive examinations to secure **40%** marks in each individual paper or to pass remaining paper & **50%** marks in the aggregate of all law papers of that class.

A candidate admitted-for the degree of LL.M.- must complete his/her degree within **04** academic years beginning from the academic year in which he/she has taken admission.

04



A Candidate who has passed his LL.M. part-I or Part-II examinations and desires to improve his performance by re-appearing shall be permitted to do so in the immediately following year in maximum **02** papers.

05



Re-evaluation shall only be permitted to the candidates to apply only in maximum **02** papers of the main examination. There shall be no revaluation in paper fifth i.e. dissertation paper code 1275-B (A)

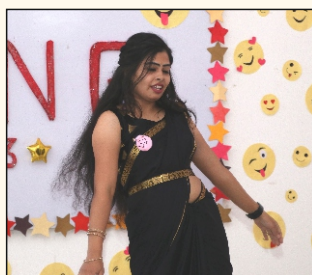
