Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application for the extension of institution's existing provisional affiliation granted by this University, I am directed to convey that the matter regarding grant of affiliation has been duly considered by the Adhoc Board of Inspection on 08.04.2026.

Based on:

- The recommendations of the duly constituted Inspection Committee;
- Verification of compliance with the conditions prescribed at the time of grant of Permanent/Provisional affiliation; and

Fulfilment of the norms and standards laid down by the concerned Statutory/Regulatory Body, including but not limited to infrastructure, faculty qualifications, academic resources, governance and student support systems; the University is pleased to grant affiliation to Shri Krishan Law College, Kotputli, Distt.- Kotputli-Behror for conducting the approved programme(s), which is as under:

2.	LL.B Three Year Programme	240	Continuation of Permanent Affiliation.

4.	PGDFS One Year Programme	40	Extension of Provisional Affiliation.

The affiliation is extended/granted subject to the following conditions:

- The affiliation is granted strictly in accordance with the provisions of the University Act, 2019.
- The College shall continue to comply with all norms and standards prescribed by the concerned Statutory Body (such as UGC and BCI).
 - If the college already has a valid approval of BCI for the session 2026-27, it can start the process of admissions against the approved seats immediately after issuance of this letter.
 - If the college does not have a valid approval of BCI for the session 2026-27, it is mandatorily required to obtain the BCI approval, or to deposit the requisite fee to BCI, within one month of issuance of this letter, for its inspection/approval for the session 2026-27 and proof of the same should be submitted to the University. The admission process can be started on compliance of the same.
- The College shall not make any change in the location, intake capacity, Programmes offered, or governance structure without prior approval of the University and the concerned regulatory authorities.
- The College shall maintain the required faculty strength, qualifications, and service conditions as per statutory norms at all times.

5. The College shall ensure continued availability of adequate infrastructure, library and other academic facilities.
6. The College will make necessary compliance with the following recommendations of BOI:
 - I. More books and journals be purchased as per BCI norms.
 - II. Moot Court should be as per BCI norms.
 - III. Sanitary conditions be improved.
 - IV. PG Diploma Forensic Lab. be established and augmented.
 - V. More smart classrooms be provided.
7. The College Shall submit compliance report/s and shall be subject to inspection by the University or any competent authority as and when required.
8. The affiliation is liable to be withdrawn or modified if any deficiency or violation of statutory provisions is found at any stage.

This affiliation shall be effective for the academic session 2026-27 for B.A. LL.B Five Year Integrated Programme (120 seats), LL.B Three Year Programme (240 seats), LL.M Two Year Programme (40 seats), PGDFS One Year Programme (40 seats), subject to continued compliance with all applicable requirements.

It is pertinent to mention that the University will not be liable, in any manner, for the admission(s) by the Law College without valid BCI approval for any UG Programme. The University will not enroll any such student unless BCI approval is submitted within prescribed time frame.
